Half of the group of more than 100 Deaf Christians from all over southern Africa spent the week learning about using sign language Scripture to evangelize and plant Deaf churches, while the other half followed a translation training we facilitated along with the SASL team and two other brothers from Kenya and Zambia.

**Praise God** for a safe and successful journey to South Africa last month to train sign language translation teams from 8 southern African countries for Sophia's recent publication, in the latest volume of Gorgias' Press series Perspectives on Linguistics and Ancient Languages



**God at Work:** 4 new prospective members, Recent baptisms, After Shock attendance, the hayrack rides with the kids attending church and Heaven's Express afterwards, The Sipes leading us with contemporary music, the Mission Sunday service and the sale of Eloise Bush house.

Pastor's Report: No report.



**Deacons Report:** Dave Weber stated the deacons present suggest that the Thanksgiving Offering again go to our local food pantry. They also recommend we donate \$500 to The Victory Center for their Thanksgiving dinner. M/S to make these donations. M/C.

Elders Report: Martha: (See Elders minutes.)

**Endowment:** Current balance is \$898,000. 00. Ken Jansma will be meeting with the Phil Renkes family soon to receive a donation from his Memorial Money.

**Finance:** Our current assets are \$453,387.56. Martha questioned the over spending on office supplies and postage and noted our building maintenance is over budget. Dave informed us there has been additional mailings this year.

Assistance/Memorial: The deacons will be making a donation of \$500 to a family in need.

**Property/Insurance:** No report.

**Church Life:** The chili cookoff will be October 19th followed by playing "Blank Slate". There will be a potluck following the Congregational Meeting on November 16. Chicken and drinks will be provided.

Worship and Music: No report.

**Youth and Education:** Jan reported they have added an additional class for PreK/K. Lori Peterson and Bernita Schafer will be the teachers. Thank you for stepping up to the plate gals!

**Sacraments and Communion:** See Elders minutes. Next communion Sunday November 30 which is the first Sunday of Advent. We had 3 baptisms in October.

**O.M.E. Task force:** Pat Pessman shared that there will be a chili cook off night October 19. We will be playing Blank Slate. This is a fun for all ages. They will be suggesting that Ryan Karp be added to our Mission donations in 2026. The Mission Sunday service was well received and they hope to do something similar next year. We will be hosting Trick or Treat on Friday October 31. Candy donations and volunteers are needed. We will hand out candy and Bible Tracks. Trivia will be in January.

**Approve Minutes:** M/S to approve September, 2025 minutes. MC.

**Old Business:** Martha Kophamer brought a list of recent and needed large building projects. There are several big-ticket items. She suggested adding (or revising Property and Insurance) a new "Building Committee" with some non-consistory members to look at the whole church and make a list of things we need to do and make a priority list and meeting regularly. The building is old. Community dinner discussion was tabled.

**New Business:** Pat Pessman would like to thank the church for allowing the historical society to use our building for their presentation this past week. About 90 people attended. (The historical society paid for the cleaning, but we do not charge them for the use of the building.) Phil Ardapple states we need additional microphones for the increase in numbers of the praise team. Reminder of the upcoming all church prayer meeting Tuesday, October 21 at 6:00. Nominees for the upcoming year are: Elders: Jon Kophamer, Melinda Hamstra and Sandi Wilkins. Deacons will be Randy Renkes and Gregg Wiersema. This will be voted on at the Congregational meeting November 16. It's time to start working on Budget for 2026. Pay raises will be discussed after adjournment and Pastor is excused to leave.

Adjournment: M/S to adjourn after prayer. M/C.

**Closing Prayer:** Dave Weber closed in prayer.

**2026 Salary Adjustments**: Discussion occurred about pay scales for 2026. **M/S** to give 3% across the board pay raises excluding Craig Sipes who was just hired in October. **M/C.** Pastor Appreciation month is October. Discussion occurred. **M/S** to give Pastor JT a monetary gift for our appreciation. **M/C.** Ken Jansma will present this during our last service in October.
